



The Gallatin Valley Farmers' Market is committed to supporting local farmers, food producers, and small business owners by providing an affordable and accessible platform to grow their businesses. Vendor spaces are primarily reserved for individuals and businesses offering homegrown, handmade, or locally produced goods.

To remain aligned with this mission and ensure our limited space is used in ways that directly support vendors and the market's financial sustainability, non-profit participation is limited to two organizations per market season. Eligible non-profits must:

- Clearly align with the market's mission by supporting local agriculture, food access, land stewardship, or community health and safety related to food and farm environments
- Not sell goods for profit
- Provide programming or information that directly supports farmers, food producers, or the local food system.

Non-profit vendors must be approved in advance and will be placed at the discretion of the Market Manager. Participation is not guaranteed year to year.

Non-profit booths are subject to the standard reservation fee and will receive \$10 off the daily booth fee.

This policy is subject to change based on space availability, demand, and the needs of the market. We value the work of local non-profits and encourage those not selected to explore other community outreach opportunities in the Gallatin Valley.
